- Free hot and cold drinks are available 24/7/365 in our Dog Waiting Room.
- An independent coffee van visits our car park twice daily (at around 10.30am and 2.30pm Monday through Friday). From there, you can purchase hot and cold drinks, snacks, and sandwiches.

Free WiFi is available on-site, and our reception areas, waiting rooms, consulting rooms and toilets are all wheelchair accessible.

Opening hours: Monday - Saturday, 12pm - 11pm, Sunday 12pm - 10pm

Hillier Garden Centre (café)

Pump Lane South, SL7 3RB

Journey from The Ralph: 4-minute drive (not walkable safely)

Parking: Plenty

Dog-friendly: Yes

Type of food/drink: Hot and cold drinks, seasonal food
Other: The garden centre itself is nice to look around, and there is a Pets Corner pet shop on-site

THINGS TO DO IN AND AROUND MARLOW

Marlow is a beautiful, historic town. The main high street is about a 20-minute walk or 5-minute drive from The Ralph. There are plenty of shops and places to eat.

Parking: There are several pay-and-display car parks near Marlow High Street (e.g. Pound Lane, Dean Street, or West Street), as well as limited on-street parking.

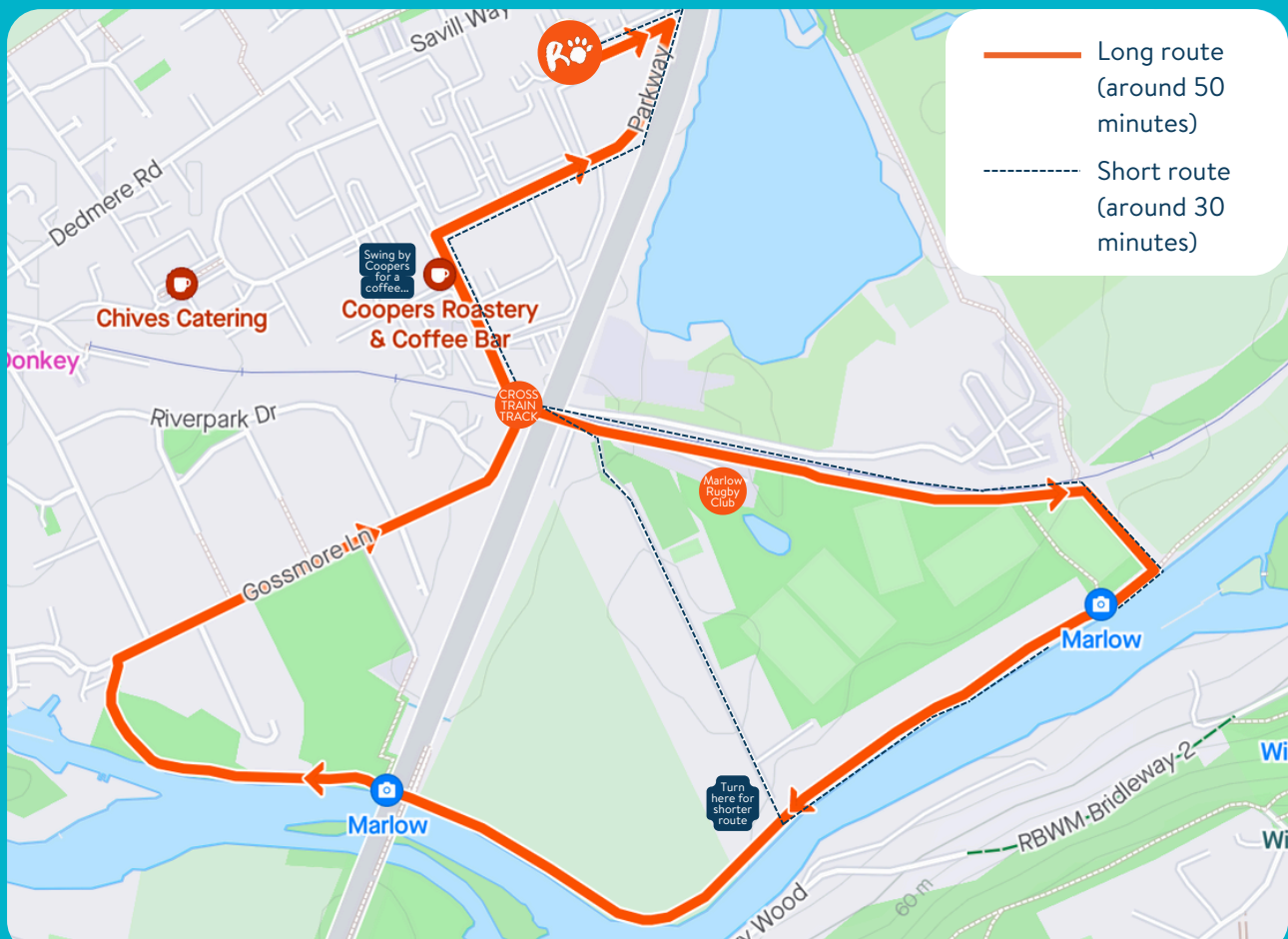
